
TOORA: a snapshot

We deliver services to women and children from diverse backgrounds. In 2019-20, 81 identified as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander and 146 from Culturally and Linguistically Diverse backgrounds.

- time in ACT Corrective Services.



TOORA DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND HOMELESSNESS SERVICES (TDVHS)

We are the largest provider of specialist homelessness and domestic violence residential and outreach support services for women in the ACT. We accept women aged 16 years or older, and their children, into our program.

We run various residential and outreach programs to provide individual case management and a range of emotional and practical support for women. These include:

- · crisis and medium-term accommodation
- finding safe and stable accommodation
- support during and after time in ACT Corrective Services safety planning and legal advice
- liaising with the immigration department to address any immigration issues
- advocacy in other areas of identified need
- budgeting and discussing access to welfare benefits
- referrals to health services and other community services
- specialist child and family support, and
- assistance with building independent living skills and community support networks.

Our case management services are free and women in our supported accommodation can receive rent assistance from Centrelink.

To better support women and their families, in 2016, we developed a partnership with EveryMan Australia to value-add our service delivery using gender-specialist case management services. Men entering our service are provided housing by Toora Women Inc. and supported by EveryMan Australia.

ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUGS SERVICES (AOD)

Toora Alcohol and Other Drugs Services offer a broad range of free health treatment and support services specifically for women with severe alcohol and other drug dependencies. Through self-referrals, we accept single women and women accompanied by children.

We provide the following AOD programs:

- long-term residential health treatment for women who have already completed a supervised withdrawal but need day-to-day support in their recovery
- short-term residential health treatment for women who have already established their recovery and seeking additional support before returning to the wider community
- an eight-week Day Program that offers relapse prevention information, education and skills building to explore their own personal issues and reach their personal goals;
- an outreach program accessible pre-and- post-treatment to all women accessing our AOD services;
- support and education to women at the Canberra Hospital
 Withdrawal Unit and the Alexander Maconochie Centre.

TOORA COUNSELLING SERVICE

We offer specialist support to women who have experienced alcohol or other drug use.

Counselling sessions may also involve addressing related trauma such as:

- · domestic, family and sexual violence
- homelessness or needing support to stay out of the homelessness system
- mental health issues, and
- time in ACT Corrective Services.

Our experienced counsellors and psychotherapists have received in-depth training and offer a range of therapeutic interventions and counselling skills.

Self-referrals from women over 18 are welcome. However, women who are already in another Toora AOD program will get priority.
